RENEWAL OF MEMBERSHIP FOR 2012

In 2009 Ice Skating Australia introduced National Registration for members of the skating community of Australia. The basis of this scheme was that skaters and others were required to pay a registration and insurance fee of \$25 directly to ISA. For the 2012 season, NSWISA have been asked to collect the \$25 registration and insurance fee on behalf of ISA. It should be noted that ISA registration is compulsory, and must be paid together with the relevant NSWISA membership fee.

The renewal of membership form will be found on the NSWISA website under the membership tab early in January 2012.

- download the application
- check the 2011 membership list for your current category of membership
 - Basic introductory and Basic must renew as Basic. ISA registration of basic (aussie skate / skate school skaters) will not be collected by NSWISA; this must be applied for and paid through home clubs or rinks. All basic and basic introductory members of NSWISA must commit to attend to this.
 - Members who renew for Senior, Junior, Synchronized or Adult (judges & officials only) are entitled to an "Early Bird" discount if they renew membership prior to 10th February, 2012.
 - Associate category is primarily for professionals to undertake tests or serve as technical personnel on the IJS system.
 - Clubs – must renew with NSWISA according to number of members however are not required to pay a registration fee to ISA.
 - To undertake an ISA test members must have Junior or Senior membership to NSWISA.
- complete all fields
- payment details - cash/cheque/credit card/electronic transfer (confirmation of transfer must be attached) – part payment will not be accepted.

NSWISA is currently in negotiation with ISA on "Volunteers". All volunteers are requested to apply for recreational membership with NSWISA; we are hopeful that NSWISA will be granted a blanket cover for these members with insurance cover. All volunteers should go to the working with children link on the NSWISA site and complete the volunteers / student declaration and lodge it with NSWISA.
