- I won't pressure my child in any way – I know that this is their sport not mine
- I will not use bad language, nor will I harass skaters, coaches, officials or other spectators
- I will encourage my child to skate within the rules and respect officials' and coaches' decisions – no matter what
- I will teach my child to respect the efforts of their competitors
- I will remember that children learn best by example so I will applaud good performances by both my child and their competitors
- I will give positive comments that motivate and encourage continued effort
- I will focus on my child's efforts and performance – not the result
- I will thank the coaches, officials and other volunteers who give their time to conduct the event for my child
- I will help when asked by a coach or official
- I won't criticise or ridicule my child's performance at any time
- I will refrain from any form of sexual harassment towards skaters, officials, coaches, administrators or other parents
- I will not arrive at the venue intoxicated or under the influence of drugs or drink alcohol or take drugs at any events
- I will not allow the unlawful supply of alcohol or drugs at training, events or club functions
- I will respect the rights, dignity and worth of all people involved in the sport, regardless of their gender, ability or cultural background.
