2. All users must ensure they are listed on the membership register before using the harness.
3. The harness is only to be used in a Figure Skating session.
4. Only a coach who has participated in the training seminar held by APSA and who has specific insurance are permitted to use the harness.
5. Once you have finished with the harness it is to be put back in its original location.
6. Any damage to the harness must be reported to the head coach or member of the committee.

NOTE: Failure to apply to any of these conditions could result in the harness being taken down.

Parents Code of Behaviour:

- ✓ Encourage children to participate and have fun;
- ✓ Focus on the child's effort and performance rather than winning or losing;
- ✓ Never ridicule or yell at a child for making a mistake or losing a competition.
- ✓ Remember that children participate in sport for their enjoyment, not yours. Encourage children to participate, do not force them.
- ✓ Focus on your child's efforts and performance rather than whether they win or lose.
- ✓ Encourage children to play according to the rules and to settle disagreements without resorting to hostility or violence.
- ✓ Remember that children learn best by example. Appreciate good performance and skilful moves by all participants.
- ✓ Support all efforts to remove verbal and physical abuse from sporting activities. Respect officials' decisions and teach children to do likewise.
- ✓ Show appreciation for volunteer officials and administrators. Without them your child could not participate.
- ✓ Respect the rights, dignity and worth of every young person regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or religion.
