Membership Requirements	<ul> <li>At close of entries, all Australian competitors <b>must</b> be a full financial member of their relevant State Association and an affiliated club. (Inclusive of ISA Insurance Registration either directly or via their state association).</li> <li>The membership must be valid during the full competition period. Upon competition online entry POAs (proof of age) <b>must</b> be entered.</li> <li>Overseas entrants must be financial members of an ISU member skating organisation and/or its affiliates, as required by their national organization; the membership must be valid during the full competition period.</li> </ul>
Insurance/Liability	All members of State Associations are covered under the ISA National Insurance Policy while participating in the event. This policy includes Sport Accident cover. ISA NSWISA and SFSC assume no responsibility for other persons in connection with this event. ISA recommends that any person travelling to an interstate event consider personal travel insurance.
Eligibility to Compete	Skaters preliminary and above must have passed the relevant test level/s at close of entries.

### ACCREDITATION

### **Competitors**

The competitor's photo accreditation lanyard **must** be visible at all times during the event. It will allow you entry into the ice rink for the duration of the four day event, breakfast service and access to the warmup area no more than 1 hour prior to the event with your coach. Without the visibility of this accreditation you will be charged an entry fee daily, not have access to breakfast service or the warmup area.

### **Chaperones**

The chaperone's photo accreditation lanyard **must** be visible at all times during the event. It will allow you entry into the ice rink for the duration of the four day event. Without the visibility of this accreditation you will be charged an entry fee daily.

### **Coaches**

The APSA photo accreditation lanyard **must** be visible at all times during the event. It will allow you entry into the ice rink, breakfast service, lunch service and dinner service. Without the visibility of this accreditation you will be charged an entry fee and not have access to catering.
