ACCREDITATION				

Competitors

The competitor's photo accreditation lanyard **must** be visible at all times during the event, except during the warmup and performance. It will allow you entry into the ice rink for the duration of the four day event, breakfast service and access to the warmup area no more than 1 hour prior to the event with your coach. Without the visibility of this accreditation you will be charged an entry fee daily, not have access to breakfast service or the warmup area.

Chaperones

The chaperone's photo accreditation lanyard **must** be visible at all times during the event. It will allow you entry into the ice rink for the duration of the four day event. Without the visibility of this accreditation you will be charged an entry fee daily.



<u>Coaches</u> The APSA photo accreditation lanyard **must** be visible at all times during the event. It will allow you entry into the ice rink, breakfast service, lunch service and dinner service. Without the visibility of this accreditation you will be charged an entry fee and not have access to catering.
