Membership Requirements	At close of entries, all Australian competitors must be a full financial member of their relevant State Association and an affiliated club. (Inclusive of ISA Insurance Registration either directly or via their state association).	
	The membership must be valid during the full competition period.	
	Failure to comply with membership requirements will result in withdrawal from the event.	
	Overseas entrants must be financial members of an ISU member skating organisation and/or its affiliates, as required by their national organization; the membership must be valid during the full competition period.	
Insurance/Liability	All members of State Associations are covered under the ISA National Insurance Policy while participating in the event. This policy includes Sport Accident cover.	
	ISA and MFSC assume no responsibility for other persons in connection with this event.	
	ISA and MFSC recommends that any person travelling to an interstate event consider personal travel insurance.	
Eligibility to Compete	Skaters Preliminary and above must have passed the relevant ISA test level at the close of entries.	
Practice Sessions	IJS divisions Preliminary to Senior will have official practice sessions on the morning of their event. Practice sessions start at 5:45am. Practice schedules will be published with the event schedule.	
	There are no official practice sessions for Theatre On Ice events.	
	Unofficial practice sessions on the competition rink will be available on Thursday 9 th August. These will need to be booked and paid for in advance, at time of Event Registration. Sessions run from 12pm-6pm and will be allocated based on skater level.	
	Additional freestyle practice sessions are available at O'Brien Group Arena during the week of the event –visit www.obriengrouparena.com.au for session times and costs. Please be aware these sessions are likely to be very busy and O'Brien Group Arena will cap sessions at 30 skaters. Visiting coaches are not permitted to take the ice but may coach from the barrier and may be charged an entry fee. Coaches may not coach more than three skaters at one time.

Entry Process and Eligibility to Compete	Online entry submitted directly to OC, MFSC by competitors The OC will provide a list of competitors to the state associations within (2) two days of close of entries. State Associations will confirm to the OC as soon as possible thereafter, the skaters' eligibility to compete as well as membership status of club and state. PPC and Music submission must be submitted with the entry.		
Conditions for Online Entry	All Interstate competitors must notify their relevant state association of their entry submission prior to entering. All state associations will be asked to confirm that entrants are full financial members in good standing, of both the state association and an affiliated club. (see above)

Entry Conditions	Entries will not be considered complete unless accompanied by: o Full Payment paid on entry o Music File – electronically submitted on entry. o Planned Program Content Sheet (PPC) for all IJS-level programs to be received on entry. Late entries will not be accepted		
	Entry will be discounted by 10% for all MFSC members. Volunteers are encouraged to sign up early. Training sessions will take place in the week prior to the event.

Trophies will be awarded to the first three place-getters of each division. All competitors will receive a participation certificate.

Crystal Challenge Perpetual Trophy

The Crystal Challenge Perpetual Trophy is awarded to the skater(s) whose attitude, performance and skating spirit stands out from the crowd, and embodies the spirit of this great sport ~ resilience, courage, expression and beauty of performance. The winner of the Crystal Challenge Perpetual trophy may come from any division from Aussie Skate to ISA IJS levels, technical or artistic. They may be a skater from any club throughout Australia.

Over each of the three days of competition, one skater/team will be selected. They will be presented with a Crystal plaque at the final award presentation each day. From these three 'runners-up', the overall Perpetual Trophy winner will be selected. The perpetual trophy will be retained by the Melbourne Figure Skating Club and will be engraved with the winner's name and displayed at O'Brien Group Arena. A representative trophy will be presented to the winner.

EVENT REGISTRATION and VENUE ENTRY

PHOTOGRAPHY

An official photographer will be taking photos at the event.

For private photographers, please note that **no** *flash* **photography** is permitted as it may be dangerous to the skaters.

VIDEOGRAPHY

Video Recording: Individuals using video cameras will be required to register at the Information / Registration desk on the day of the event.

Camera lights are prohibited.

Videoing can only be undertaken in the designated area.

All private photographers are required to check in at the Registrations desk on the day of the event.

Permissions are to be requested at the time of entry.

PHOTOGRAPHY AND VIDEO OF PRACTICE SESSIONS AND OFFICIAL WARMUPS ARE STRICTLY PROHIBITED.
