<b>Divisions</b>	<p>Singles: Aussie Skate, Preliminary, Elementary, Basic Novice, Intermediate Novice, Intermediate, Advanced Novice, Junior, Senior and Adult Divisions (Copper, Bronze, Silver, Gold, Masters, Elite Masters)</p> <p>Pairs/Groups: Novelty Pairs, Novelty Groups.</p> <p>***Some divisions may be combined or divided following the close of entries at the discretion of the Convener***</p>
