DIVISIONS All divisions as per ISA Division Guidelines and Required Elements.

MUSIC Electronically to NSWISA website > Forms > Upload Music or select THIS LINK.

All music must be submitted with the entry or by close of entries otherwise the entry

will be deemed incomplete and may not be accepted.

A backup CD should be available at the competition if required. All CDs MUST be clearly

marked with competitor's name, event and music time, be of good quality and

submitted in a separate case for each CD.

ELIGIBILITY All competitors must be current NSWISA members or another State Association, a

member of an Affiliated Club and registered with ISA. Skaters will not be permitted to

compete if all memberships are not current.

Previous winners of NSWISA Aussie Skate divisions may not re-enter the division won except where there were less than 3 entrants in that division, but may enter a higher division even though they may not have yet passed the necessary test

level.

Skaters may not enter a division lower than that for which they have passed the

Care must be taken that all competitors are entered in the correct divisions, as

changes may not be allowed due to scheduling.

EVERYONE involved in the sport (including skaters, officials, parents, guardians and coaches) must adhere to all ISA and NSWISA Rules, Regulations and Policies.
