Policies/Procedures/Forms:			

1. Purpose of the Policy

This Policy establishes the criteria for entry to the annual NSWISA State Artistic Championships. The Policy outlines the eligibility of all skaters intending to participate in the Championships, both NSWISA Members and Guests.

2. Application of the Policy

This Policy applies to all eligible NSWISA Members and Guests of other State Associations and ISU Members. This Policy applies to all divisions forming part of the Championships.

3. Eligibility

To be eligible to enter the NSWISA State Artistic Championships, competitors must meet the following criteria as at close of entries for the Championships:

- Each skater must be a financial Member of NSWISA or another State Association or ISU Member and a home Club
- Each skater must hold the relevant ISA test level to compete as per the relevant ISA By-Laws
- For NSWISA Members, each skater must have competed in or entered and then competed in after close of entries for the NSW Artistic Championships, at least one Artistic event in NSW in the time between the last NSW Artistic Championships and the Artistic Championships they are entering (with the NSW Artistic held on 7th April 2019 being counted as the start date for 2020 eligibility)
- For Guests, entries must be approved by the skater's/skaters Association/Member and will be approved by the Championship Organising Committee after consideration

In cases of exceptional circumstances where skaters are not able to meet the above criteria, applications may be made to the NSWISA Executive and Championship Organising Committee for review. Supporting documentation may be required.

Entries to the NSWISA State Artistic Championships must be made using the NSWISA online registration system available at www.nswisa.com. Music and payment must be submitted at the time of entry for the entry to be accepted.
