

ANNOUNCEMENT – Online Event Australian Figure Skating Competition 2021

	ISA Champ Series Event (Benchmark panels & ranking scores) – skaters may use this event to gain or improve their ISA rankings. All Entries will be online through your home State.
Event Status	ISA will NOT use this event to determine entries to the ISU Four Continents Figure Skating Championships – selection for entries to the ISU Four Continents Figure Skating Championship, ISU World Figure Skating Championships & ISU Junior World Figure Skating Championships will be as per ISA-03. For synchronized skating selection to International Synchronized Skating Events and ISU World Synchronized Skating Championships & ISU World Junior Synchronized Skating Championships, please refer to SS21-05P and SS21-06F.
Firest Date	Skaters entered will be able to be skate their programs between 26.11.21 - 10.1.22
Event Date	Entries will be determined by State Associations, with a maximum of FOUR skaters/teams from each state in each division. ISA reserves the right to accept additional entries if circumstances allow.
Entry Dates	State entries by number – 14 Dec., 2021 State entries by name – on submission of videos and completed PPCs.
Draw	To be determined by State Associations.
Judging & Results	Draw may be undertaken by a Referee or Judge or State Official to determine the initial skating order at each rink.
	It is envisaged that the judging will take place pprox 12-18 Jan, 2022 and that the results will be announced by the end of Jan. 2022.

Event Venue	Any ice rink
Technical Requirements	As per current I <u>SU</u> and I <u>SA Technical</u> requirements refer: ISU Special Regulations and Technical Rules ISU Communications ISA Regulations and Communications
Results	The IJS (ISU Judging System) will be used for all Divisions. This will be the ISU online version of the system. Results will be displayed when they are certified by the division Referee and Technical Controller and posted on the ISA website.
Feedback	 After the ISA online event the Controller(s) will invite specialists and judges to participate in feedback sessions in the following groups: Group I -Preliminary and Elementary Skaters Group II- Basic Novice and Intermediate Novice Group III- Advanced Novice and Junior. Group IV-Senior A zoom session will take place and each group I-III will be assigned a 30-minute time slot where general feedback about performances/levels will be given to the coach and skater. Senior feedback will be only for those who are intending to compete in an ISU Championship or Winter Olympic Games and will be done individually in a ten minute time slot. Skaters and Coaches can ask questions to clarify call/marks and to see how to improve. Any skater under 16 years of age can also have a parent present. The parent is there as an observer only for child protection. The zoom session times will be emailed to the State secretaries for distribution.



Event Officials	Each State Association is invited to nominate a Judge or Judges,
Event Officials	Technical Controller and/or Technical Specialist and Data Operator/Video Replay Operator for any scheduled events.
	These should be submitted in writing to the OD Judging.
Membership Requirements	At close of entries, all Australian competitors must be a full financial member of their relevant State Association and an affiliated club. (Inclusive of ISA Insurance Registration either directly or via their state association).
	The membership must be valid during the full competition period.
	Australian skaters based overseas may also enter.
	The verification of the entry in these cases, shall be done by an ISA official watching and recording for verification the entry being created.
Insurance/Liability	All members of State Associations are covered under the ISA National Insurance Policy while participating in the event. This policy includes Sport Accident cover.
	ISA & ISA Member State Bodies assume no responsibility for other persons in connection with this event.
Other Requirements	COVID-19 Safety Plans may/may not be operational at the ice rink in which you skate the competition. Compliance with these requirements is controlled by the ice rink and Member State Body. Skaters should appraise themselves of the requirements in the rink in which they will skate.
	All people entering the rink are required to comply with rink directions relating to public health and safety.
Eligibility to Compete	Skaters Preliminary and above must have passed the relevant ISA test level/s at the close of entries.
Practice Sessions	Unofficial practices will be dependent upon the individual State Association arrangements.



COMPETITION ENTRY DETAILS

Entry Conditions, Payment Process and Eligibility to Compete

Entries are to be submitted by States direct to ISA via an online registration system that ISA will advise.

In addition to online registration, for Synchronized Teams, State Associations must submit fully checked and completed SS21-04F-V2 Team Entry Forms to the Chair of the ISA SyS Committee by 14 December 2021. Forms received directly from Teams will not be accepted.

The relevant State Association will ensure that all entrants are eligible to compete, and their membership status is current.

The State Association may charge a fee to cover ice time if the event is skated in this way.

When the State Association uploads the video/s, the PPC needs to be uploaded at the same time. This should be completed by 12.1.22

Conditions for Online Entry	Athletes are nominated by their State Associations for entry to AFS Competition 2021. All State Associations will be asked to confirm that entrants are full financial members in good standing, of their State Association.
Anti-Doping Controls	Anti-Doping tests may be conducted in accordance with the ISA Anti- Doping Policy and ISU Anti-Doping Rules and Procedures. Competitors should ensure that they are aware of these rules and especially those regarding leaving the venue after an event.
Music	Music procedure is as per the ISA Music Provision Policy. Refer ISA Music Protocol All competitors will have on hand at the event a back-up copy of their music, on CD and/or USB with only 1 track on the device. Mobile phones will not be accepted as back-up music device. Further details and specific requirements of this will be as determined by State Associations.
PPC	PPC is included as part of the online competition entry.
Schedule	State Associations are responsible for scheduling.
Awards/Trophies	Medals will be awarded to the first three place-getters of each division.
