Hunter Ice Skating Club Code of Behaviour – Officials and Volunteers



In the interest of safety and harmony of skating, Officials and Volunteers should observe the following Code of Behaviour.

- 1. Place the safety and welfare of members above all else,
- 2. Be impartial, consistent, objective, and respectful when dealing with skaters, parents/guardian, members of the club, judges and officials and members of the public,
- 3. Accept responsibility for your actions and decisions,
- 4. Refrain from any form of personal abuse or sexual harassment towards skaters, parents, coaches, or officials,
- 5. Must hold a WWCC and provide the WWCC number, expiry date and Date of Birth to the Secretary,
- 6. Refer any complaints or issues to the Committee as per the complaint form,
- 7. Avoid any situations which may lead to or be construed as a conflict of interest,
- 8. Be approachable and offer assistance, where possible, or refer them to a member of the Committee,
- 9. Alcohol or drugs are not permitted while volunteering, and
- 10. Respect the rights, dignity and worth of all people involved in the sport, regardless of their gender, ability, or cultural background.
