## Hunter Ice Skating Club Code of Behaviour - Parents



In the interest of safety and harmony of skating, parents should observe the following Code of Behaviour.

- 1. Encourage children to participate and have fun,
- 2. Focus on the child's effort and performance rather than winning or losing,
- 3. Remember that children participate in sport for their enjoyment, not yours. Encourage children to participate, do not force them,
- Encourage children to participate according to the rules and to settle disagreements without resorting to hostility or violence,
- 5. Remember that children learn best by example,
- 6. Appreciate good performance and skillful moves by all participants,
- 7. Support all efforts to remove verbal and physical abuse from sporting activities. Respect officials' decisions and teach children to do likewise,
- 8. Show appreciation for volunteers, officials and administrators. Without them your child could not participate,
- Non skaters/parents are not allowed on the change room side of the rink past the toilets or to be in the penalty box/ middle box,
- 10. Non skaters/parents are not permitted close to the barrier (including at the Perspex), if a parent wishes to speak with a coach or skater, the coach or skater are to leave the ice and step away from the barrier (unless in emergency situations such as injury),
- 11. If a parent chose to change coach/es, they should be respectful by notifying the current coach/es first, and
- 12.Respect the rights, dignity and worth of a person regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background, or religion.
