## **Hunter Ice Skating Club Code of Behaviour - Skaters**



In the interest of safety and harmony of skating, coaches and skaters of all levels should observe the following Code of Behaviour.

- 1. Give your best at all times,
- 2. Participate for your own enjoyment and benefit,
- 3. Follow all rules and regulations,
- 4. Never argue with an official. If you disagree have your coach approach the referee of the event after the competition,
- 5. Control your temper. Verbal abuses of officials, sledging other skaters or deliberately distracting or provoking an opponent are not acceptable or permitted,
- 6. Work equally hard for yourself and/or your team. Be a good sport,
- 7. Treat all participants in your sport as you like to be treated. Do not bully or take unfair advantage of another competitor,
- 8. Cooperate with your coach, team-mates, and other athletes. Without them, there would be no competition,
- 9. When using any recording device (such as mobile phones) on the ice, ensure that you are aware and considerate of other skaters, and
- 10. Respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background, or religion.
