

Hunter Ice Skating Club Financial Support



Financial support is available in specific circumstances for Hunter Ice Skating Club Members holding a current financial membership.

To be eligible for financial support skaters must:

- have skated for HISC and no other club for the whole of the previous two Club financial years ending (31st December), and
- have competed in Preliminary or above, or Adult Bronze or above.

If at any time the Club receives sponsorship, then those funds must be allocated in the best interest of the entire Club. Any funds received must be presented to the following Committee Meeting. Individual sponsorship shall be the sole responsibility of the Member.

Applications for funding are to be made to the Committee prior to attending the Training and Development or International competition. Proof of registration and attendance is required prior to funding being provided.

The funding is subject to the financial position of the Club.

In the circumstances of the high popularity of a training and development opportunity, the Committee may offer a partial payment rather than the full application amount.

Approved State or National Training and Development**	50% of the cost of registration up at \$100 per year per skater***
Approved international Training and Development	50% of the cost up to \$500 per year per skater ***

* this is not transferable for cash. To be eligible skaters must not receive financial support from another Ice-Skating Club for the Club financial year, other than prize money, sponsorship and appearance money.

** the Committee will not provide funding for Hunter Ice Skating Club hosted Training and Development.

*** cost can include registration, travel and accommodation. If the member received funding from another association (NSWISA, ISA and/ISU), this will be taken away from the HISC funding. The purpose of this policy is to subsidise expenses and should not exceed the financial costs of the opportunity. Lost income, meal allowance, taxis/airport transfers, and travel insurance are not eligible for reimbursement.
